
The Constitution was created to govern the Government, not the people, and not the states, each of which is a guardian of its own sovereignty.

State Controlled Economies

(The difference between these is how much is owned or controlled outright by the government.)

COMMUNISM - ALL capital is owned and controlled by the State. No pretenses.

SOCIALISM - Gov't acquires major industries like transportation, utilities, and communications to leverage control over entire economy.

NAZISM (National Socialism) - Like Fascism except Hitler owned many larger companies like Volkswagon.

FASCISM - Gov't doesn't own but does control businesses. More efficient, because owners think they still own, but are really controlled by an array of taxation and regulation.
